

BID FOR CYLINDER MACHINING JOB ON ORDER OF CRISP, BHOPAL

SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE NIT FOR CYLINDER MACHINING

The job work in question is very important and needs precision work. It also calls for timely supply of machined cylinders back to CRISP. We shall like to have a fair assessment of the capability and dependability of the partners having undertaken to work with us. Before the job is entrusted for machining, we shall like the vendors to ensure compliance of the following specific Terms and Conditions:

1. Rates of machining Job per item shall include taxes and packing charges.
2. Machining of the cylinders shall be performed strictly as per the Drawing made available to you alongwith the contract / work order.
3. Delivery of the machined cylinders shall be ensured strictly as per the time schedule given in the **contract**.
4. To and fro transport costs shall be met by the Vendor. The Vendor shall lift cylinders from CRISP's campus and deliver the same after the machining job has been duly performed.
5. The rates shall be valid initially till the completion of the machining job performed on 6000 cylinders right now but the contract could be extended for a further period till CRISP still has cylinders requiring the machining job.
6. This process may take a full year to complete. In that case, the rate of machining job now sanctioned shall prevail. The Vendor may please note this. **Any default in performance or jumping the contract shall attract strict penalty besides forfeiture of EMD and SECURITY DEPOSIT and legal action for breach of contract.** The amount of penalty shall be finalized by the Chief Executive Officer after taking into account all the circumstances. The amount of penalty fixed by the CEO, CRISP shall be final and binding.
7. The Vendor shall be entitled to retain the whole scrap.
8. Payment shall not be made for any rejection or rework.
9. Preference in allotment of the jobs shall be given to the Vendors who are capable of handing over to CRISP atleast 300 pieces of machined cylinders **per week**. We expect our partners to do whatever in their power to maintain the delivery schedule.
10. Any gauges etc. required by the Vendor shall have to be obtained from its own resources.
11. CRISP is committed to provide to the Vendors packing material (corrugated sheets of appropriate size) for the machined items.
12. Before finally deciding on the choice of vendors CRISP shall like to ensure availability of various resources that should enable the vendors to cope up with the job. The Vendors are, therefore, required to give the following information alongwith the bid with regard to the resources:

- (a) Manpower:

- (i) Number of qualified and experienced machinists and supervisors, their qualifications and years of experience of executing machining jobs.
 - (ii) We shall make verification through testimonials that shall be made available in a separate cover kept in the sealed cover alongwith the Bid.
 - (iii) Number of shifts of work per day (2 shifts / 3 shifts of 8 hours each (to be specified).
 - (iv) Specifications, make and number of lathe or other machines available in your workshop.
 - (v) Annual turn-over of the firm for the last 5 years (Rs. in lakhs).
13. CRISP shall undertake inspection of your WORKS for verification of facts / data reported in your bid.
14. In the normal course, there should not be any conflict between our 2 parties, CRISP on the one side and the Vendor on the other side. In case, there is a dispute requiring intervention of a court of law, jurisdiction of the courts shall be Bhopal.
15. There is a separate Annexure giving the **general terms and conditions** that shall also be applicable to the contract of machining job in question.
16. Kindly ensure that each paper / document is signed by your authorized signatory with the official seal affixed on it.
17. Also require:
- (a) Address of the Works / Factory with its exact location;
 - (b) Telephone / Mobile number for contact;
 - (c) Name of Authorized contact person;
 - (d) Email ID.
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
